Gender equality and sustainable development, Europe and new generations, fight against Mafia and corruption, culture and urban revival: these are the themes of the events and initiatives organized for the Internazionale Festival with the partnership of UnipolSai and Unipolis

## Bologna, 25 September 2017

The Internazionale Festival in Ferrara, held from 29 September to 1 October, is a major event where an ever-growing young audience can meet with journalists, experts and scholars from all over the world.

**UnipolSai** and **Fondazione Unipolis** also support this year's festival, in line with the principles that characterise Unipol's business, inspired by social and economic responsibility, attention to the individual and choices for the future and new generations.

In particular, the Unipolis Foundation shared and cooperated with Internazionale for the definition and organization of topical events: gender equality and sustainable development, Europe and new generations, fight against Mafia and corruption, culture and urban revival.

On **Friday 29 September** at the New Theatre, Romano Prodi, economist, scholar and former Italian Prime Minister, will talk with sociologist Ilvo Diamanti. They will discuss the economic and social crisis in Europe and its effects on new generations. Journalist Tonia Mastrobuoni from the newspaper La Repubblica will introduce and moderate the debate.

On **30 September**, in the courtyard of the castle, there will be a discussion on the evolution of the relationship between organized crime and corruption for the presentation of the fifth volume of the *Atlante delle mafie* by Enzo Ciconte, Francesco Forgione and Isaia Sales, which addresses the issue from a historical and sociological point of view. **Pierluigi Stefanini, Chairman of the Unipol Group and Unipolis Foundation**, Federico Cafiero De Raho, Public Prosecutor of Reggio Calabria, Piergiorgio Morosini, Judge of the Superior Council of the Judiciary, Enza Rando of the Libera Association will take the floor. Orsetta Giolo from the University of Ferrara and Christian Ponti of the University of Milan will introduce and moderate the discussion.

Again this year, the 2017 edition of the Internazionale Festival in Ferrara will be enriched by the presence of the Libero Cinema in Libera Terra caravan, the travelling film initiative against mafias promoted by Cinemovel Foundation, of which **Unipolis** is an institutional partner.

Two screenings have been programmed: on Friday 29 September *Mexico! Un cinema alla riscossa* by Michele Rho. The event will be opened by Mafia Liquida / Live-motion cinema: a collective work with Vito Baroncini behind the projector. The second screening is scheduled on Saturday 30 September, of *La rivoluzione in onda* by Alberto Castiglione.

This event will be opened by the national premiere of *Rifiutopoli. Poisons and antidotes, conference* - a show by Vito Baroncini in dialogue with Enrico Fontana, created with the support of the **Unipolis Foundation**. Appointment at 21:30 at Factory Grisù - Garden District, via M. Poledrelli 21.
