

## UNIPOLSAI RIDING WITH THE DUCATI TEAM ALSO IN THE 2018 MOTOGP SEASON

Renewal of the partnership between the Unipol Group's insurance company and the Borgo Panigale manufacturer for the MotoGP World Championship
